- Check-In is available Friday evening and will begin 30 minutes prior to doors opening to the public on Saturday.
- All coaches must check-in to receive their Coaches/USASF credentials.
- Please bring the following items to registration: USASF Rosters/ ID (All Star)
 - USASF Compliance Cover Sheet (All Star)
 - Rec Verification Form (Rec)
 - USA Cheer Proof of Membership (Rec/School)
 - Waiver Forms PER ATHLETE & PER COACH (Rec/School)
 - Team Roster (Rec/School)
 - Proof of music license (All performances)
- At this time, you will sign all necessary Bid Intentions.

Warm up/Rehearsal:

- Everyone entering the warm-up room, and not in uniform, must be wearing their USASF/USA Cheer approved wristband.
- Please check into warm-up no less than 10 minutes prior to your scheduled warm-up time.
- For athlete changing areas, please utilize the facility restrooms. Do not change in open areas.
- Each team will receive the following warm-up:
 - Stretching station
 - o 18' x 54' Skills Mat
 - 12' x 70' Tumbling Strip o 54' x 42' Foam Floor with music

Scoring:

- This event will feature the following scoring breakdown: 25% (Day 1 performance)/75% (Day 2 performance).
- Scoresheets will be sent to the email attached to the team, or registration contact, approximately 15-20 minutes after each performance. Paper copies will be available upon request at the scoresheet table. *The coaches attached to your teams will receive their team's scoresheets at the event ONLY if their email AND mobile number is added and correct on the portal account.
- ACCUscore will be located directly behind the Judging Platform. Any requests for review must be submitted within 10 minutes after the scoresheets have been emailed.
- Final results will be available for coaches in the event Coaches BAND, following awards.

Awards:

- Awards ceremonies will take place live in Room W311. Please check the final schedule for the exact division/session times.
- All team members will receive a medallion, and National Champions receive a Champion Award.
- All awards must be picked up on-site. Awards will not be shipped post-event.

 - The D2 Summit 2 Partial Paid, 4 At-Large Bids
