- Check-In will begin 30 minutes prior to doors opening to the public.

### Warm up/Rehearsal:

- Everyone entering the warm-up room, and not in uniform, must be wearing their USASF/USA Cheer approved wristband.
- Please check into warm-up no less than 10 minutes prior to your scheduled warm-up time.
- For athlete changing areas, please utilize bathrooms or come in uniform.
- Each team will receive the following warm-up times.
  - Level 1 and 2
    - 8 mins – 18' x 54' Foam Floor
    - 8 mins – 12' x 72' Spring Tumble Strip
    - 4 mins – 42' x 54' Foam Floor (with audio)
  - Level 3-6
    - 8 mins – 42' x 54' Foam Floor
    - 8 mins – 42' x 54' Spring Floor
    - 8 mins – 42' x 54' Foam Floor (with audio)

### Scoring:

- This event will feature the following scoring breakdown: 25% (Day 1 Performance)/ 75% (Day 2 Performance).
- Scoresheets will be sent to the email attached to the team, or registration contact, approximately 15-20 minutes after each performance. Paper copies will be available upon request at the scoresheet table.
- ACCUscore will be located behind the judges riser. Any requests for review must be submitted within 10 minutes after the scoresheets have been emailed. ***The coaches attached to your teams will receive their team's scoresheets at the event ONLY if their email AND mobile phone number is added and correct on the portal account.***
- Final results will be available for coaches following the awards ceremonies.

### Awards:

- Awards ceremonies will take place on the competition stages. Please check the final schedule for the exact division/session times.
- All teams will receive a medallion, and an team award (1<sup>st</sup> – 3<sup>rd</sup> place).
