Please send 1 representative to check-in your program. All coaches & personnel needing to enter warm-ups must present proof of greenlight to receive USASF/USA Cheer wristband.

Division Splits:

- ATC will split Small/Medium when there are at least TWO teams in each division.
- ATC will split D1/D2 when there are at least TWO teams in each division.
- After this, ATC will follow the USASF guidelines split guidelines

Scoresheets:

Scoresheets will be printed approximately 15-20 minutes after each performance and will be available at the scoresheet table in the respective hall you competed in.

Accuscore:

Accuscore is located in the main Hall closest to **Hall B** next to the judge's riser in the **Coaches Only** section. Any requests for review must be submitted within 15 minutes after the scoresheets have been printed/emailed.

Results:

- **Day 1 Results (Division Standings/Averages)** will be available e-mailed approximately 1 hour after the last team in the division performs.
- **Day 2 Results (Division Standings/Averages)** will be available approximately 30 minutes after Awards are announced and will be e-mailed.
- **Final Event Rankings** will also be available Tuesday following the event at Varsity.com/ATC

Official Warm-up/Rehearsal:

Friday Night Warm-ups – Report 4th Floor
Saturday and Sunday Warm-ups - Report to Meydenbauer Theatre (2nd floor)

- Everyone entering the warm-up room, and not in uniform, must be wearing their USASF/USA Cheer approved wristband.
- Please check in to warm up no less than 10 mins prior to your warmup time.
- The Meydenbauer does offer limited spaces designated as performer changing areas. But we encourage you to utilize your hotel rooms or the Hyatt Grand Ballroom.

Spectator Info:

- In order to enter the facility, spectators must be wearing a purchased **Spectator Ticket Wristband**. To receive the wristband, spectators must either:
 - Present proof of vaccination
 - OR**
 - Present proof of *Negative COVID Test
- ***Negative COVID Test must be dated no earlier than Wednesday, January 26th for entrance on Friday, January 28th.**
- ***Negative COVID Test must be dated no earlier than Thursday, January 27th for entrance on Friday, Saturday or Sunday (January 28-30)**
- **Masks must be worn at all times indoors regardless of vaccination status**
- Admission (Via EventBrite)
 - Two day \$20
 - One day \$10
- Friday Admission is only offered as a one day ticket.
- Children 5 & under are free
- ***We strongly recommend purchasing your tickets in advance to expedite the ticketing process on-site at the event – and recommend screenshotting your ticket to avoid technical delays that may hold up the line.***
