- Check-In will begin at 7:30am on Saturday.

- At this time, you will sign all necessary Bid Intentions.

Warm up/Rehearsal:

- Everyone entering the warm-up room, and not in uniform, must be wearing their USASF/USA Cheer approved wristband.
- Please check into warm-up no less than <u>10 minutes</u> prior to your scheduled warm-up time.
- For athlete changing areas, please utilize the facility restrooms. Do not change in open areas.
- Each team will receive the following warm-up:
 - o 6 min 18' x 42 Foam Floor
 - 6 min 12' x 69' Spring Tumble Strip
 - 6 min 42' x 54' Foam Floor (with audio)

* More information on the amount of time per station will be provided closer to the event.

Scoring:

- This event will feature the following scoring breakdown: 25% (Day 1 performance) / 75% (Day 2 performance)
- Scoresheets will be sent to the email attached to the team, or registration contact, approximately 15-20 minutes after each performance. Paper copies will be available upon request at the scoresheet table.
- ACCUscore will be located directly behind the Judging Platform. Any requests for review must be submitted within 10 minutes after the scoresheets have been emailed. *The coaches attached to your teams will receive their team's scoresheets at the event ONLY if their email AND mobile phone number is added and correct on the portal account.
- Final results will be available for coaches in the event Coaches BAND, following awards.

Awards:

- Awards ceremonies will take place on site during the event.
- All teams will receive a medallion, and a Team Award (1st - 3rd place).
- National Champion Towels for 1st place teams.
