Registration/Check-in:

- Check-In will begin 30 minutes prior to doors opening to the public at 7:30 AM.
- All Coaches must check-in to receive their Coaches/USASF event credentials. Please bring a photo ID.

 - Waiver Forms PER ATHLETE & PER COACH (Rec/School)
 - Team Roster (Rec/School)
 - $\circ~$ Proof of music license (All performances)
- At this time, you will sign all necessary Bid Intentions.

Warm up/Rehearsal:

- Everyone entering the warm-up room, and not in uniform, must be wearing their USASF/USA Cheer approved wristband.
- Please check into warm-up no less than <u>10</u> <u>minutes</u> prior to your scheduled warm-up time.
- For athlete changing areas, please utilize the facility restrooms. Do not change in open areas.
- Each team will receive the following warm-up times.
 - o 6 mins 18' x 42 Foam Floor
 - $\circ~6$ mins 12' x 60' Spring Tumble Strip
 - $\circ~$ 6 mins 42' x 54' Foam Floor (with audio)

Scoring:

- Scoresheets will be sent to the email attached to the team, or registration contact, approximately 15-20 minutes after each performance. Paper copies will be printed and available at the scoresheet table.
- ACCUscore will be located behind the judges platform. Any requests for review must be submitted within 10 minutes after the scoresheets have been emailed. *The coaches attached to each team will receive that team's scoresheet ONLY if their email AND mobile phone number is added and correct on the portal account.
- Final results will be available to coaches in the BAND, following awards.

- All teams will receive a medallion, and 1st -3rd will receive a Team Award.


