- Check-In will begin 30 minutes prior to doors opening to the public.
- All coaches must check in to receive their Coaches/USASF credentials.
- Please bring the following items to registration:

 - USASF Compliance Cover Sheet (All Star)
 - Rec Verification Form (Rec)
 - USA Cheer Proof of Membership (Rec/School)
 - Waiver Forms PER ATHLETE & PER COACH (Rec/School)
 - Team Roster (Rec/School)
 - Proof of music license (All performances)
- At this time, you will sign all necessary Bid Intentions.

Warm up/Rehearsal:

- Everyone entering the warm-up room, and not in uniform, must be wearing their USASF/USA Cheer approved wristband.
- Please check into warm-up no less than 10 minutes prior to your scheduled warm-up time.
- For athlete changing areas, please utilize facility restrooms. No changing allowed in common areas.
- Each team will receive the following warm-up times.
 - 6 mins – 18' x 42' Foam Floor
 - 6 mins – 12' x 60' Spring Tumble Strip
 - 6 mins – 42' x 54' Foam Floor (with audio)

Scoring:

- Scoresheets will be sent to the email attached to the team, or registration contact, approximately 15-20 minutes after each performance. Paper copies will be available upon request at the scoresheet table. ***The coaches attached to your teams will receive their team's scoresheets at the event ONLY if their email AND mobile phone number is added and correct on the portal account.**
- ACCUscore will be located next to the judging platform. Any requests for review must be submitted within 10 minutes after the scoresheets have been emailed.
- Final results will be available for coaches in the Coaches BAND following awards.

Awards:

- Awards ceremonies will take place on the main competition floor. Please check the final schedule for the exact division/session times.
- All teams will receive a medallion, and a Champion Award.

Bids:

- The following Bids will be awarded at this event:
 - The Summit – 5 Wild Card Bids
 - The D2 Summit – 5 Wild Card Bids
 - The Regional Summit – Points Series
 - The U.S. Finals – Golden Tickets
 - The Quest – 1 Bronze Bid

Division Splits:

- D1/D2 splits will be guaranteed in every (Elite & Prep Cheer) division, then will follow the USASF split guidelines by team size. No additional D2 recognition awards given beyond the awards in each division.
