- At this time, you will sign all necessary Bid Intentions.

Warm up/Rehearsal:

- Everyone entering the warm-up room Hall A, and not in uniform, must be wearing their USASF/USA Cheer approved wristband.
- Please check into warm-up no less than 10 minutes prior to your scheduled warm-up time.
- Each team will receive the following warm-up times.
 - 6 mins – 18' x 42' Foam Floor
 - 6 mins – 12' x 60' Spring Tumble Strip
 - 6 mins – 42' x 54' Foam Floor (with audio)

Scoring:

- Scoresheets will be sent to the email attached to the team, or registration contact, approximately 15-20 minutes after each performance. Paper copies will be available upon request at the scoresheet table.
- ACCUscore will be located behind the judge's riser. Any requests for review must be submitted within 10 minutes after the scoresheets have been emailed.
- Final results will be available for coaches at (BAND & email), following awards.

- Awards ceremonies will take place in Hall B, the performance hall. Please check the final schedule for the exact division/session times.

Spectator Info:

- Doors to the facility will open at 10 AM.
- Please use the Main Entrance to CHI Health Center Convention Center entrance & follow signs to the performance area (Hall B).
- The cost for admissions will be:
 - \$10 for Adults (17-64) with additional fees – 1-Day
 - \$5 for Students (6-16)/Military/Seniors (65+) with additional fees – 1-Day
 - Children 5 & under are Free
- Tickets can only be purchased onsite at the Box Office. CHI Health Center is a cashless venue and accepts CARD ONLY.
- The facility has restrictions regarding the following:
 - No outside food or drink allowed.
 - NO Cash Accepted

Parking Info:

- The facility will charge a parking fee of \$10 a vehicle with no in and out privileges. Please park in the B or D lot.

- Performance order will be publicly available on Tuesday prior, November 2nd.

Performance Viewing:
