# Warm up/Rehearsal:

- Everyone entering the warm-up room, and not in uniform, must be wearing their USASF/USA Cheer approved wristband.
- Please check into warm-up no less than 10 minutes prior to your scheduled warm-up time.
- For athlete changing areas, please utilize the facility restrooms. Do not change in open areas.
- Each team will receive the following warm-up:
  - o 8 mins 42' x 54 Marley Floor (stretch/routine marking)
  - o 8 mins 42' x 54' Marley Floor (with audio)

# Scoring:

- · This event will feature the following scoring breakdown: 25% (Day 1 performance) / 75% (Day 2 performance).
- · Scoresheets will be sent to the email attached to the team, or registration contact, approximately 15-20 minutes after each performance. If there is not a valid contact attached, you will not receive an email. Paper copies will be printed and available at the scoresheet
- Division Standings and Averages will be posted in the Coaches BAND on Saturday on a similar schedule as the Sunday Awards Schedule. Results will be available for coaches in the Coaches BAND following awards.
