Registration/Check-in:

- Check-In will begin once the doors open to the public at 7:00AM.
- All coaches must check-in to receive their Coaches/USASF event credentials. Please bring a photo ID.
- Please bring the following items to registration:

 - o USASF Compliance Cover Sheet (All Star)
 - o Rec Verification Form (Rec)
 - o USA Cheer Proof of Membership (Rec/School)
 - Waiver Forms PER ATHLETE & PER COACH (Rec/School)
 - o Team Roster (Rec/School)
 - o Proof of music license (All performances)
- At this time, you will sign all necessary Bid Intentions.

Warm up/Rehearsal:

- Everyone entering the warm-up room, and not in uniform, must be wearing their USASF/USA Cheer approved wristband.
- Please check into warm-up no less than <u>10 minutes</u> <u>prior</u> to your scheduled warm-up time.
- For athlete changing areas, please utilize the facility restrooms. Do not change in open areas.
- Each team will receive the following warm-up:
 - o 8 min 12' x 42 Foam Floor
 - $\circ~$ 8 min 12' x 60' Spring Tumble Strip
 - o 8 min 42' x 54' Foam Floor (with audio)
- * More information on the amount of time per station will be provided closer to the event.

Scoring:

- Scoresheets will be sent to the email attached to the team, or registration contact, approximately 15-20 minutes after each performance. If there is not a valid contact attached, you will not receive an email. Paper copies will be printed and available at the scoresheet table.
- ACCUscore will be at the judges riser. Your
 ACCUscore time limit is posted at the top righthand
 side of your scoresheet.
- Division Standings and Averages will be posted in the Coaches BAND following awards.

- Awards ceremonies will take place live.
- · All athletes will receive a medallion.
- 1st- 3rd will receive team banners.
