Warm up/Rehearsal:

- Everyone entering the warm-up room, and not in uniform, must be wearing their USASF/USA Cheer approved wristband.
- Please check into warm-up no less than <u>10</u> minutes prior to your scheduled warm-up time.
- Each team will receive the following warm-up times.

 - 6 mins Foam Floor
 - \circ 6 mins Spring Tumble Strip ○ 6 mins –Foam Floor

Scoring:

- Scoresheets will be sent to the email attached to the team, or registration contact, approximately 15-20 minutes after each performance. Paper copies will be available upon request at the scoresheet table.
- ACCUscore will be located at the Judges' Area. Any requests for review must be submitted within 10 minutes after the scoresheets have been emailed. *The coaches attached to your teams • Additional Issues or Concerns: will receive their team's scoresheets at the event ONLY if their email AND mobile phone number is added and correct on the portal account.
- Final results will be available for coaches on BAND following awards.

Awards:

- Awards ceremonies will take place after each session. Please check the final schedule for the exact division/session times.
- All teams will receive a medallion, and a Team Banner $(1^{st} - 3^{rd} Place)$.
