Registration/Check-in:

- Check-In will open starting at 3:00 PM on Friday, January 14th.
- Check-In will begin 15 minutes prior to doors opening to the public on Saturday & Sunday.
- Please bring the following items to registration:

 - USASF Compliance Cover Sheet (All Star)
 - Rec Verification Form (Rec)
 - USA Cheer Proof of Membership (Rec/School)
 - Waiver Forms PER ATHLETE & PER COACH (Rec/School)
 - Team Roster (Rec/School)
 - Proof of music license (All performances)
- At this time, you will sign all necessary Bid Intentions.

Warm up/Rehearsal:

- Everyone entering the warm-up room, and not in uniform, must be wearing their USASF/USA Cheer approved wristband.
- Please check into warm-up no less than 5 minutes prior to your scheduled warm-up time.
- Each team will receive the following warm-up times.
 - 7 mins – 18' x 42' Foam Floor
 - 14 mins – 12' x 60' Spring Tumble Strip
 - 7 mins – 42' x 54' Full Spring Floor (with audio)

Scoring:

- Scoresheets will be sent to the email attached to the team, or registration contact, approximately 15-20 minutes after each performance. Paper copies will be available upon request at Accuscore.
- ACCUscore will be in room 145. Any requests for review must be submitted within 10 minutes after the scoresheets have been emailed.
- Final results will be available for coaches in the coaches BAND following each division being closed out on Day 1 and following awards ceremonies on Day 2.

Awards:

- Awards ceremonies will take place in Hall J/K. Please check the final schedule for the exact division/session times.

Bids:

- The following Bids will be awarded at this event:
 - Worlds Bids – 6 Paid & 18 At-Large Bids
 - The Summit Bids – 6 Paid, 12 At Large Bids, & 4 International At-Large Bids
 - The D2 Summit Bids – 6 Paid & 12 At-Large Bids
 - The Regional Summit Bids – Top 3 in eligible divisions will earn an At-Large Bid
 - The U.S. Finals Bids – 34 Golden Tickets will be based on registration
 - The Quest Bids – 2 At-Large Bids will be awarded based on registration

Division Splits:

- D1/D2 division splits will be offered per the USASF split guidelines. For any Elite Cheer division not split D1/D2, with more than 2 teams, a D2 Champion in those divisions will be verbally recognized during awards at the event.

Music:
