Warm up/Rehearsal:

- Everyone entering the warm-up room, and not in uniform, must be wearing their USASF/USA Cheer approved wristband.
- Please check into warm-up 40 minutes <u>prior</u> to your scheduled warm-up time.
- For athlete changing areas, please utilize the facility restrooms. Do not change in open areas.
- Each team will receive the following warm-up:
- Prep Warmup:
 - o 6 min 12' x 42 Foam Floor
 - o 6 min 12' x 69' Spring Tumble Strip
 - o 6 min 42' x 54' Foam Floor (with audio)
- Elite Team Warmup:
 - o 8 min 12' x 42 Foam Floor
 - o 8 min 12' x 69' Spring Tumble Strip
 - o 8 min 42' x 54' Foam Floor (with audio)

Scoring:

- Scoresheets will be sent to the email attached to the team, or registration contact, approximately 15-20 minutes after each performance. Paper copies will be available for pick-up at the scoresheet table.
- ACCUscore will be located directly behind the Judging Platform. Any requests for review must be submitted within 10 minutes after the scoresheets have been emailed. *The coaches attached to your teams will receive their team's scoresheets at the event ONLY if their email AND mobile phone number is added and correct on the portal account.
- Final results will be available for coaches in the event Coaches BAND, following awards.
