
JESSICA MCDERMOTT


ZOE ALECE YOCKEY MANUTES


TIY MAURQUICE ALLEN FOUNTAIN


IAN B PUDGE


TRICIA SCHRAMM


BRADLEY ALLEN ELINE


LAUREN MARIE PEETZ


CHERYL D RIVERA




JOYCE WHITAKER


KELLY LYNETTE PROCTOR


LINDSEY DRISKILL


Ken Porter is a graduate of Auburn University, where he served a student manager for the basketball team.




In addition to collegiate coaching, Dante was a member of the NCA Staff for 13 years, and he has been judging all-stars, high school, and college cheer for 14 years.


BRANDON L NORBECK


CARSYN NORWAY


MATTHEW SKORCZ


