

2024-2025 Varsity All Star Worlds Bid Declaration

This document includes the Worlds Bid Declaration for all Varsity All Star Event awarding bids to the Cheerleading Worlds—with the exception of both CHEERSPORT Nationals and NCA All-Star Nationals. Those two events will have separate bid declarations posted on those event pages.

PAID bids are always awarded to the teams with the highest Percentage of Perfection score.

PAID BIDS

Events with 1 Paid Bid

- At events with 1 PAID bid, the Paid bid will be awarded to the eligible team with the highest Percent of Perfection score.

Events with 2-4 Paid Bids

- At least 1 of the PAID bids will be awarded in a Senior division.
- No more than 1 PAID bid will be awarded in Non-Tumbling division.
- PAID bids must be awarded in at least two different divisions.

Events with 5 or 6 Paid Bids

- At least 2 of the PAID bids will be awarded in Senior divisions.
- No more than 2 PAID bids will be awarded in Non-Tumbling divisions.
- PAID bids must be awarded in at least three different divisions.

AT-LARGE BIDS

AT-Large Bids will be awarded to eligible teams with the highest Percent of Perfection score.

*When 2-4 At-Large bids are awarded, at least 1 will be awarded to a Senior Division.

*When 6 or more At-Large bids are awarded, at least 2 will be awarded to Senior divisions.

Teams who earn a PAID bid will receive monies directly from Varsity All Star to be applied to their Worlds registration. If a team either decides not to attend Worlds or if Worlds is canceled for any reason, PAID bid money will need to be returned to Varsity All Star.

TIE BREAKER POLICY

In the event that there is a tie for a Worlds bid, the following Tie-Breaker policy will apply:

- The bid will be awarded to the team with the least amount of deductions for Performance 2.
- If the deductions for Performance 2 are equal or zero, the team with the least amount of deductions for Performance 1 will be awarded the bid.
- If the deductions for Performance 1 are equal or zero, the bid will be awarded to the team with the highest Performance 2 score in the Showmanship category.
- If the Performance 2 Overall Impression category scores remain equal, the bid will be awarded to the team with the highest scoring Performance 1 score in the Showmanship category.
- If the Performance 1 Showmanship category scores remain equal, the tie will be broken by the Judges' Choice.

The following events require a program to register and compete at least three teams in order to be eligible for a Worlds Bid:

- *The American Grand (Las Vegas, NV)*
- *Spirit Sports Grand Nationals (Palm Springs, CA)*
- *USA All Star Super Nationals (Los Angeles, CA)*

No other Varsity events require a three team minimum in order to be eligible.
