Head Judge Michelle Allison is in her 28th year as Artistic Director of Curtain Call Dance Center, Indianapolis, IN. Received a B.S. in Dance Performance from Ball State University. Michelle directs the Sr. Performing Company, the annual productions of The Nutcracker and Dance Against Cancer at Curtain Call where she develops curriculum and continuing education. She has judged The Dance Worlds since the inaugural year and is currently the Panel Director for Jazz. Since 2010, Michelle has been choreographer for the Colts NFL Cheerleader auditions and halftime shows. She has been a guest judge/master instructor with JCDA Tokyo, Japan, for ten years and is a veteran judge of CheerSport, Spirit of Hope, MA Dance, The Groove Experience, UDA College Dance Nationals, NFL Colts and Ben-Gals. She spent 13 years teaching for the National Dance Alliance, choreographed and field produced numerous bowl games and nationally televised parades and has judged NDA Regionals, All-Star and College Nationals since 1992.



ERIN HAROLD ALVARADO

Erin Alvarado is in her ninth year as the Pom Squad coach at Texas Tech University. In 2017, she led her team to the squad's first national championship in school history in Division 1A Jazz at NDA. Her team has won National Titles in three consecutive year's—being crowned 1A Jazz Champions in 2017 & 2018, and 1A Pom Champions in 2018 & 2019. While at Texas Tech, her teams have travelled to Shanghai, China to represent the USA in their annual Tourism Festival, and have performed alongside the Dallas Cowboys Cheerleaders many times. Erin is a graduate of West Virginia University with a B.S. in Exercise Physiology and a minor in dance. She was a member of the WVU Dance Team, and then coached for three years where the team won two consecutive NDA Collegiate National Championships in 2010 & 2011. She is an adjudicator for NDA, UDA, USA, USASF, PrimeTime Dance and Showbiz Talent. Erin has travelled to Tokyo, Japan & Australia to judge for JCDA and AASCF nationals. At Texas Tech, Erin currently serves as an Adjunct Faculty in jazz, contemporary, hip hop, movement for the performer and tap. She also travels around the world teaching master classes, setting choreography and speaking at various events. She has been a guest speaker at various conferences, is a member of NDCA, and is the Category Director for the Contemporary/Lyrical division at The Dance Worlds. In 2019, Erin was voted the National Collegiate Dance Coach of the Year by the National Dance Coaches Association.

She was a choreographer and head instructor for the National Dance Alliance, spent 7 years as their Event and Curriculum Director, and has field produced numerous special event half time shows during her tenure with NDA. In 2017 was awarded the Herkie Legacy Award for her commitment to the industry. Currently, Cheryl is the USASF Dance Adjudication Director and Communications Coordinator and serves as the Pom Panel Director at The USASF Dance Worlds. Brian Cao has been involved in the spirit industry for over 20 years on the school, all-star, collegiate and professional levels. In 2007 & 2008, Brian served as a Co-Show Director for the Thanksgiving in Paradise Halftime Show in Hawaii, and his choreography opportunities have taken him all around the world, including to England, Finland and Japan. In 2010, Brian received the coveted Herkie Legacy Award for his contributions to NCA/NDA, The Work is Worth It Award in 2016, and most recently, the 2019 NCA Heart & Soul Award. Brian's dance resume includes performing with several companies in Oregon, including three seasons with the NBA Portland Trailblazers Jam Squad. He currently works as a choreographer and consultant to cheer and dance teams of all levels and was the choreographer for Team England Freestyle Pom in 2018. In his limited free time away from training, he travels the world speaking at conferences, judging for major cheer and dance events, and is a 4-time judge for The USASF Dance Worlds.

Her teams have earned numerous regional and state titles, are perennial finalists at UDA Nationals and are 5x Academic State Champions. Most recently, Rock Canyon earned two Bronze medals at the 2020 NDTC and in 2018 they were selected as the Varsity Brands American Spirit Leader Award winner. In 2015, Christina was the National winner of the Double-Goal Coach Award from the Positive Coaching Alliance and in 2016 named Coach of the Year by the Colorado HS Coaches Association. Christina grew up as a competitive figure skater while also training in dance before joining her high school & college dance teams. Outside of coaching, Christina is an active adjudicator and conference speaker.
