Registration will be held in Canal Meeting Room E (Mezzanine Level of Convention Center). You must register all your teams at one time. If you are signed up for a Friday practice round spot, you must register your team(s) before you start your practice time.

#### **Practice Rounds**

One Up opens the Warm-up area to competitors and coaches on Friday, April 8<sup>th</sup> from 4:00pm – 9:00pm. Parents and spectators are not permitted in the Warm-up area at any time.

You are able to request up to a MAXIMUM number of practice spots that is equal to 50% (round up) of teams registered by your program for the event. Example: ABC Allstars registers five teams. They are eliqible to request three practice times.

#### The Summit and The D2 Summit Bid Intention

You will be asked to declare your bid intentions for The Summit & The D2 Summit at Event Registration.

#### **Worlds Bid Intention**

You will be asked to declare your bid intentions for The Cheerleading Worlds or Dance Worlds at Event Registration.

#### Coaches Registration: Friday, April 8th

Coaches Registration will be held in Canal E Meeting Room (located on the Mezzanine Level of the Convention Center – located directly above the Delta Ballroom). Coaches Registration will be open from 1pm – 9pm. Friday Registration is MANDATORY for ALL TEAMS. Registration on Saturday will not be available. Please plan your travel accordingly.

#### **Competition Halls**

- ⇒ 3 Competition Halls are located in the Convention Center section of the Gaylord Opryland Resort (Delta A, Delta D, & Governors)
- ⇒ 1 Competition Hall is located in the Gaylord Opryland Event Center (GOEC)
- ⇒ All practice areas are located on Level 0 in Ryman C1/C2.

#### **Performance Floors**

- ⇒ All CHEER teams will compete on a 54x42 spring floor.
- ⇒ All DANCE teams will compete on a 54x42 marley dance floor.



#### **Scoresheet Pick-Up & Division Standings**

Scoresheets are emailed approximately 15-20 minutes after the team's performance. You can also receive a printed set at the back of the Judge's Stand in the Hall where you performed. If you do not receive the email, the printed copy will be your next best option. Please confirm that the correct email is associated with the individual you want to receive the scoresheets via email.

Division Standings and Division Average Reports can be viewed in the Coaches BAND approximately 90 minutes after the division ends, or after the division awards ceremony.

#### **ACCUscore Routine Review Process**

ONE UP uses the Varsity All Star AccuSCORE Routine Review Process. Please read it over carefully to provide your programs with the best use of this review process. The AccuSCORE Review form can be found at the Scoresheet Pick-Up table in each hall. Please bring the completed form to the AccuSCORE review area, located in Canal Meeting Room A (Mezzanine Level of the Convention Center). Please make sure you understand how to get to this area should you need it, so you don't miss your designated AccuSCORE window. Your AccuSCORE time limit is printed on the top right-hand corner of your score sheet.

#### Scoring - Final Rankings

The final results are a combination of a team's round one and round two scores.

- ⇒ Round 1 Score = 25% of final score
- ⇒ Round 2 Score = 75% of final score

#### **Coaches Hospitality**

The Coaches Hospitality Area will be located in Canal Meeting Rooms B-E, located on the Mezzanine level of the Convention Center (above the Delta Ballroom). The Hospitality Area will be open Friday, Saturday and Sunday. There will be Cash Concessions available for you to purchase in the Hospitality Area (with both hot & cold items). Come and relax with your fellow coaches!

#### Warm-Up Area

Only coaches with BOTH event credential lanyard AND wristband (affixed to wrist) will be allowed into the Warm-Up area. Team members (in uniform) will also be allowed in the Warm-Up area as well. Please, no sister team members, or extra coaches in warm-up.

The Warm-Up area is located on Level 0 of the Convention Center in Ryman C1/C2. All teams will access the Warm-Up area through the hall that leads into Ryman C1. Please follow all signs to the warm-up check-in area.

Please take some time to familiarize yourself with the Resort, and plan out the best route for your teams to meet and get to the warm-up area so you are not late for your Report time. Remember that parents are NOT allowed to enter the Warm-Up area.

#### **ONE UP Competitor Gift**

Each competitor will receive a One Up commemorative competition gift. At Event Registration, coaches will be given one gift per registered competitor at the event. ONE UP is not responsible for lost or stolen gifts.

#### Video/Media Policy

No Commercial Recording (audio or video) or commercial live-streaming is allowed in the event venue or other event-related venues (including, but not limited to, hotels and restaurants) or on the grounds of any such venues (collectively, "Event Locations"). In addition, the personal, non-commercial use of live streaming apps (such as Periscope, Facebook Live, etc.) to capture all or any part of a performance during the event is not permitted. By attending/ purchasing admission to the event, each attendee grants permission to Varsity Spirit, LLC and its affiliates, designees, agents, licensees, and invitees to use the image, likeness, actions and statements of the attendee in any live or recorded audio, video, film, or photographic display or other transmission, exhibition, publication, or reproduction made of, or at, the event in any medium, whether now known or hereafter created, or context for any purpose, including commercial or promotional purposes, without further authorization or compensation.

#### **Interruption of Performance**

- UNFORSEEN CIRMCUMSTANCES
  - (A) If, in the opinion of the competition officials, a team's routine is interrupted because of failure of the competition equipment, facilities, or other factors attributable to the competition, the team affected should STOP the routine.
  - If the coach chooses to stop the routine at the point of technical difficulties, the team will not have the option to perform again. Please note: All phones should be in Airplane Mode and the person in charge of pressing play needs to know the pass code to the phone in case it locks. At least one coach MUST remain at the music stand for the duration of the routine. If not, you forfeit the right to be able to stop the music.
  - (C) The team will perform the routine again in its entirety, but will be evaluated ONLY from the point where the interruption occurred.

#### 2. FAULT OF TEAM

(A) In the event a team's routine is interrupted because of failure of the team's own equipment, the team must either continue the routine or withdraw from the competition.

#### 3. INJURY

- (A) They only persons that may stop a routine for injury are:
  - a) Competition Official
  - b) Gym Owner/Coach from the team performing
  - c) an injured individual
- (B) The competition officials will determine if the team will be allowed to perform at a later time. The spot in the schedule where the re-performance is to take place is at the sole discretion of competition officials. The team may perform the routine again in its entirety, but only be evaluated ONLY from the point where the interruption occurred.
- (C) The injured participant that wishes to perform may not return to the competition floor unless:
  - 1. The competition officials receive clearance from, first, the medical personnel attending to that participant, the parent (if present) AND THEN the head coach/advisor of the competing team.
  - If the medical personnel do not clear the participant, the participant, the participant can only return to the competition if a parent or legal guardian in attendance signs a return to participation waiver.
  - Any athlete who exhibits signs or symptoms consistent with a concussion should be removed from the activity at that time and should not be allowed to return to activity on a subsequent day until evaluated by and receives written clearance for such participation from a qualified physician (MD or DO specifically trained in concussion management).
- (D) In addition to the USA Cheer head injury policy, we encourage you to be familiar with specific laws of the state where the competition is being held.

All skills must be performed full-out from the beginning of the routine. All point deductions accumulated to that point (if any) will carry over.

If a team is permitted to perform again, but fails to perform the routine in its entirety (example: throwing back tucks instead the full twist thrown in the original performance), it is at the discretion of the Competition Director how that team's scores will be affected.








## **Event Map**

#### **Code of Conduct**

- Guests will be respectful to all other visitors, participants, staff, and convention center property.
- Guests will always comply with the direction and instructions from hotel staff.










## **Warm-Up Flow**
