



Spirit Festival Nationals – VIRTUAL Frequently Asked Questions

Here are some things to know before you register. As details are finalized, information will continue to be added to this document.

Event Date: March 13, 2021

Who can participate in the Spirit Festival Nationals Virtual event?

- Teams who are currently registered will be able to participate in the Spirit Festival Virtual Nationals.
- After current registered teams, it will be open to all divisions on a first come first serve basis until we hit our capacity.

Will divisions be split into DI & DII programs during the event?

Yes, all divisions will be split in accordance with the recommended guidelines from the USASF.

Will Non-Building Division splits be offered?

Due to the End-of-Season Bids being awarded, Non-Building splits will not be offered for this event.

Where will I be able to keep up with all the details regarding this event once I am registered?

You will be invited via email to join the private, coaches-only event BAND. The event BAND will be extremely helpful to registered coaches, it's a perfect place where answers can be quickly found and questions can be quickly answered.

How will a Virtual Competition work?

Teams will receive an email with a link to the applicable Varsity TV video uploader and keyword to use for filming routines. Once this information is sent, teams will have a 5-day window to record their video and submit it, following the uploader steps provided. At the close of submissions, routines will be available to watch for all subscribers on Varsity TV. Varsity All Star Certified Judges will score routines in our Simple Score system and teams will receive standard scoresheets and feedback. Results & Bids will be announced for FREE the following week on Varsity TV.

All routines will be judged with sound and available for Varsity TV subscriber viewing with sound for 48 hours once the event goes live. After 48 hours, the routines will be available without sound for Varsity TV subscribers. After 5 days, routines will be available free of charge without sound for the duration of the competition season.



Event Timeline:

- **3/02/2021** – Registration Closes. This is a firm deadline and will not be extended.
- **3/03/2021** – The Registration Contact will receive the official event timeline, filming guidelines, and a link to the Coaches and Gym Owners ONLY BAND.
- **3/04/2021** – The Registration Contact will receive information about the Worlds eligible team Roster Verification process.
- **3/06/2021** - The Registration Contact will receive the KEY WORD to use in filming your video and may start the filming process in your facility.
- **3/08/2021** - The Registration Contact will receive a form to declare for End-of-Season Championship Bids.
- **3/10/2021** - The Registration Contact will receive a link & instructions to upload your video to Varsity TV and AccuSCORE information. Videos are due on 3/10 at 11:59pm CT.
- **3/13/2021** - Event will be visible on Varsity TV for on-demand viewing. Team Coach Contacts will receive an email the day of with your deductions and scoresheet.
- **3/16/2021** – Event results will be posted on Varsity TV and a special Spirit Festival Nationals Bid Reveal show will be available to watch for FREE.

How much does it cost to participate in a Virtual Competition?

Each athlete will pay \$99 to compete at the Spirit Festival Virtual Nationals. There is no crossover fee.

What awards will be given?

Champions in each division will receive a Spirit Festival long sleeve spirit tee. Placement banners will be awarded to teams in each division.

How will bids to The Cheerleading Worlds be awarded?

The Spirit Festival Virtual Nationals will award Worlds bids per the Varsity All Star Worlds bid policy and scale [HERE](#). Additional bid information and declarations will be coming soon.

Bid Eligibility

Event Producers have the right to investigate any and all teams receiving a bid to Varsity Spirit & Varsity All Star End-of-Season Events. Bid eligible teams and divisions will be reviewed for accuracy and legitimacy to ensure each team has the same opportunity. Any bid eligible team/athlete found in violation of a USASF or Varsity Spirit policy will be disqualified from their End-of-Season Championship for the remainder of the 2020 – 2021 season.



Can I compete for bids at multiple events on the same weekend?

Team competing in multiple events, both live and virtual will only be considered for bids at one event. For teams competing in a live and virtual event in the same weekend, you must declare which event you will accept bids at. For teams competing in multiple virtual events on the same weekend, they will be considered for the event that is awarding the highest level of bids (Paid, Partial-Paid, At-Large, etc.). If both events are awarding the same level of bids, your team will need to declare which event you will be accepting bids at.

Registration Deadline

Registration will close when we reach our capacity or 11 days prior to the Spirit Festival Virtual Nationals on Tuesday, March 2, 2021.

Rosters

Team rosters will be required for teams to participate in the Spirit Festival Virtual Nationals. Teams will be able to upload their roster in their USASF portal under Spirit Festival.

Worlds Roster Verification

Each Worlds Bid eligible team is required to provide the following information to Lori Nichols (lnichols@varsity.com) via email by the upload date. This email must include TWO attachments:

1. A clear, team photo of all participants so that all faces may be identified.
 - a. One participant in the photo must hold up the Keyword Template. This must be completed in dark marker so that all information can be easily read. The Keyword for this event will be shared via email and in the BAND - please follow all the directions provided when filling out the Keyword Template.
 - b. Participants should be wearing the same uniform or practice wear as the video. Meta data of both the photo and video will be reviewed to make sure they were both taken on the same day.
2. The team's USASF Roster for this event.

Music Guidelines

All routines will be judged with sound and available for Varsity TV subscriber viewing with sound for 48 hours once the event goes live. After 48 hours, the routines will be available without sound for Varsity TV subscribers. After 5 days, routines will be available free of charge without sound for the duration of the competition season.

How do people watch the event?

Varsity TV will host this event and one one-month subscription will be given to each registered program. All Varsity TV subscribers will be able to watch the event in its entirety. Routine



videos will be FREE to all viewers 5 days after the event. The Spirit Festival Virtual Nationals Bid Reveal show and posted results will be FREE to all viewers on Varsity TV.

How do I claim my Varsity TV account?

As the host of this event, Varsity TV will be giving one FREE one-month subscription to each registered program. If you are claiming a brand new account, Varsity TV will send you an email with your login credentials by the uploader day. If you have created an account at some point with the provided email, your account will simply be reactivated by the uploader day.

What kind of video do I need to submit?

Teams must submit a video recording of their routine taken in their practice facility, using the keyword indicated during the filming period. The keyword will be share in the coaches only event BAND, so be sure to join.

Videos must be one take, with sound – edited footage will not be accepted. All 4 corners of the floor should be visible when possible and athletes must perform on a USASF approved surface. The program must own rights to this video and consent to it being posted on Varsity TV for use in the Virtual Competition.

Once routine videos are filmed, they will be uploaded to Varsity TV. There is no need to purchase additional equipment or internet services for your program – simply film on your phone or available camera!

What should my team wear?

Teams may submit videos in their practice wear or uniforms. Please keep in mind that all [USASF Athletic Performance Standards](#) must be maintained.

How will teams be scored?

Once routine videos are filmed and uploaded to Varsity TV, a Varsity All Star certified judging panel will score the routines in our Simple Score system. Score sheets and division breakdowns will be emailed to coaches, just like at an in-person event.

Teams will receive a link to our AccuScore review process prior to the start of the event and will be able to follow the steps similar to a live event for challenges. Our AccuScore experts will review your sheets and follow up with your program on any changes or clarifications prior to the awards announcements.
