Registration/Check-in:

Georgia Ave. Pre-function/Lobby

- Check-in times will be available:
 - Friday, January 21st – 6:00-9:00 PM
 - Saturday, January 22nd – 6:15 AM – TBD
 - Please arrive at least 30 minutes prior your warm-up time
- Please bring the following items to registration:
 - USASF Rosters/ ID (All Star)
 - USASF Compliance Cover Sheet (All Star)
 - Rec Verification Form (Rec)
 - USA Cheer Proof of Membership (Rec)
 - Waiver Forms PER ATHLETE & PER COACH (School & Rec)
 - Proof of music license (All performances)
- At this time, you will sign all necessary Bid Intentions.

Warm up/Rehearsal:

- Please check into warm up no less than 10 mins prior to your scheduled warm-up time.
- Everyone entering the warm-up room, and not in uniform, must be wearing their USASF/USA Cheer approved wristband.

Scoring:

- Scores for all Elite teams will be combined: 25% for Day 1 and 75% for Day 2
- Scoresheets will be sent to the email attached to the team, or registration contact, approximately 15-20 minutes after each performance. Paper copies will be available upon request at the scoresheet table.
- ACCUscore is located in **Room 150**. Any requests for review must be submitted within 10 minutes after the scoresheets have been emailed.
- Results will be available for coaches in the COACH Band and at ACCUscore room following the awards.

Bids:

- The following Bids will be awarded at this event:
 - Worlds Bids – 2 PAID / 6 At-Large
 - This event has a 3 Team (Elite or Prep) Requirement for Eligibility.
 - Please refer to the 2021-2022 Worlds Bid Declaration for additional information
 - The Summit Bids – 3 PAID / 5 At-Large / 4 INT At-Large
 - The D2 Summit Bids – 3 PAID / 5 At-Large
 - The Regional Summit Bids – Top 3 in eligible divisions earn At-Large Bids
 - The U.S. Finals Bids – Gold Tickets (based on registration)
 - The Quest Bids – 1 PAID, TBD At-Large (based on registration)

Awards:

- Awards Ceremonies will be VIRTUAL for this event. Please check the final schedule for the exact division/session times.
- Champion Award pickup is located at the **Mississippi Ave. Pre-Function/Lobby**.

Division Splits:

All-Star

- D1/D2 splits will be guaranteed in every (Elite Cheer) division, then will follow the USASF split guidelines by team size. No additional D2 recognition awards given beyond the awards in each division.

Recreation

- Recreation cheer divisions may be split into Small and Large divisions provided there are at least 2 teams left in each division (see official rules). Divisions may be (not required) further split by squad size if there are at least 10 or more teams in the division. This will clearly identify the number range for the split, and label the two groups, "A", and "B". This split may not occur unless a minimum of 2 teams are left in group A and B.

Music:

- We are not responsible for providing an adapter for phones that do not have a traditional headphone jack.
- Main floor & practice area will provide sound systems that will be equipped for iPod/Phone use.

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Spectator Info:

- The Boardwalk Hall Box Office will be open for advanced ticket purchase on Friday, January 21st from 4:30-8:30 PM.
- Doors Open at 6:15 AM on Saturday & Sunday. Please use the Boardwalk entrance & follow signage to the performance locations.
- The cost for admissions will be:
 - \$25 for Adults (17-64) – 1-Day
 - \$15 for Students (6-16)/Military/Seniors (65+) – 1-Day
 - \$45 for Adults (17-64) – 2-Day
 - \$25 for Students (6-16)/Military/Seniors (65+) – 2-Day
 - Children 5 & under are Free
- The facility has restrictions regarding the following:
 - No outside food or drink allowed.

- Performance order will be publicly available on January 18th.

Parking Info:

- **BOARDWALK HALL PARKING @ Mississippi Avenue & Boardwalk.** Turn right onto Fairmount Avenue for one block and turn left on Mississippi Avenue. Follow Mississippi Avenue 4 blocks to Boardwalk. Garage entrance down tunnel to the right.
- **PARKING LOT @ The surface lot at Pacific and Georgia avenues (across from Boardwalk Hall)** Proceed 3 blocks to Pacific Avenue. Turn right and proceed for 2 blocks and turn right on Georgia Avenue. Entrance directly on right. Special event rates and reduced rates for daily parking.
