

2021 UCA ALL STAR WORLDS BID INFORMATION



UCA WORLDS BID PROCESS

UCA will be awarding 3 PAID bids, 9 At Large Bids and 1 At Large Global/Non Tumbling bid at the 2021 UCA International All Star Championship. The process for awarding bids to the 2021 Cheerleading Worlds will be as follows:

UCA will award the 1 PAID BIDS to the All Girl Division highest scoring eligible team in the following 5 divisions:

Level 6 Senior - XSmall

Level 6 Senior - Small

Level 6 Senior - Medium

Level 6 Senior - Large

Level 6 Senior - Open

UCA will award 1 PAID BID to the Coed Division highest scoring eligible team in the following 6 divisions:

Level 6 Senior Coed - Xsmall

Level 6 Senior Coed - Small

Level 6 Senior Coed - Medium

Level 6 Senior Coed - Large

Level 6 Senior Open Coed - Small

Level 6 Senior Open Coed - Large

UCA will award 1 PAID BID to the International Division highest scoring eligible team in the following divisions:

Level 6 International Open

Level 6 International Open Coed - Small

Level 6 International Open Coed - Large

Level 6 International Open - Non-Tumbling

Level 6 International Open Coed - Non-Tumbling

Level 6 International Global

Level 6 International Global Coed

Level 7 International Open

Level 7 International Open Coed - Small

Level 7 International Open Coed - Large

AT-LARGE BIDS

UCA will award 9 AT-LARGE BIDS to the next overall highest scores within the divisions listed above. An additional 1 AT-LARGE BID guaranteed in the Global / Non Tumbling divisions. In the event that any of these teams have previously earned an AT-LARGE BID from another event producer, UCA will move the extra bid(s) to the next overall highest score(s) within these divisions.

GENERAL BID INFORMATION

Teams will be required to turn in a bid acceptance form for all worlds bid eligible teams. If teams do not turn in their intention form we will assume that team will not accept any bids.

If any team has received a PAID BID from another event producer, UCA will award the bid(s) to the remaining overall highest scoring team.

In the event of a tie for any Worlds Bid position, UCA will award the bid to the team with the HIGHEST DAY 2 final score.

Winning a division will not guarantee a PAID or AT LARGE bid.

The division in which the team is awarded a bid at the 2021 UCA International All Star Championship is the division in which the team must compete at The 2021 Cheerleading Worlds.

Teams outside of the United States are NOT eligible to receive a Worlds bid. US Protectorates Countries such as Puerto Rico, Guam and the US Virgin Islands do not qualify as US Teams based on their own independent National Sport Authority Infrastructures.
