Frequently Asked Questions



Will this apply to regionals and/or state competitions?

We will continue to split into S/M/L at regionals if a division has 10 or more teams. From there, if any of the S/M/L divisions have 10 or more teams then we will split again into DI/DII.

Why is Super Varsity Game Day no longer offered?

Combining Super Varsity and Large Varsity together will align with our other categories while also creating the deepest competition for the DI/DII split.

Does this affect Junior Varsity or Junior High divisions?

No. At this time, the Junior Varsity and Junior High divisions will be the same as previous years.

Can we elect to move up from DII to DI?

No. Teams must compete in the correct division based on their school size. They will continue to be able to choose to compete in S/M/L based on the size of their team.

What information is being used to determine enrollment size?

DI and DII will be based on school enrollments in the 9th - 12th grades as of October 1, 2023. Schools will submit an official letter signed and verified from your registrar's office on school letter head with your total enrollment information. The enrollment size at that time will determine if they compete in DI or DII for the season.

What happens if my school size fluctuates during the school year?

We understand that school sizes fluctuate all season long. Therefore, we will be using the enrollments in the 9th-12th grades as of October 1, 2023 to determine the teams division for the season.

Will this affect anything for UDA Summer Camp?

Game Day routines are not allowed for Home Routine, so there will be no changes to UDA Summer Camps.

What does this mean for other divisions in the future?

At this time, the DI/DII split only applies to the Game Day divisions. We will continue to monitor the size of divisions at NDTC as well as throughout the season as we have always done. Any changes made will be out of necessity to guarantee the highest quality of the event, judging, and experience for teams.
