REGIONAL DIVISION SPLITTING GUIDELINES

Varsity Divisions will only be split at regional competitions if there are 11 or more teams in a category. Junior High and Junior Varsity divisions will not be split at any event.

- Divisions will first be split into DI (1400+ school enrollment) & DII (1399 or less school enrollment)
- If there are 11 or more teams in the DI or DII split, there will be an additional split into size as long as there are at least 3 teams in each size split.

Performance Categories

- Varsity DI: Small (5-12 members), Medium (13-16 members), or Large (17+ members)
 - Exception: High Kick will only be split Small (5-14 members) and Large (15+ members). Pom, Jazz, and Hip Hop will split Small, Medium, and Large.
- Varsity DII: Small (5-12 members) or Large (13+ members)

Standalone Dance Game Day Categories

- Small (5-12 members), Medium (13-16 members), or Large (17+ members)

NOTE: This is not applicable to Spirit Program Game Day Divisions

Recreational Division will only be split at regional competitions by age and category. No Rec Divisions will be split by size.

2026-2027 SCHOOL TEAM PARTICIPATION GUIDELINES				
All teams in the Varsity, Junior Varsity or Junior High divisions must be an official school dance team. The Junior Varsity Division is any official school dance team that is recognized by their school as the Junior Varsity or "B" Team. Individuals are NOT permitted to compete in two divisions within the same school. Exception: Dance Game Day				
Junior Varsity and Varsity teams may combine to compete in the Varsity Dance Game Day division only. Teams that combine to compete in Varsity Dance Game Day may not also compete separately in their respective Junior Varsity or Varsity Game Day divisions at the same event. All athletes must meet Varsity age requirements (8th–12th grade).				
Varsity Intermediate Divisions will be offered with skill restrictions. If you choose to compete in Intermediate you must stay in Intermediate for all categories with the exception of Game Day and Kick. See the full Rules and Regulations for details.				
Teams who compete in DI High Kick and one other performance category (Pom, Jazz, or Hip Hop) will base their second performance on the size division chosen for DI High Kick. Teams will be permitted to compete in their second performance category (Pom, Jazz, or Hip Hop) in one division smaller or one division larger than their Kick division. ° Example 1: Team A chooses DI Large Kick with 15 participants, allowing them the option to compete DI Medium or DI Large Pom. ° Example 2: Team B chooses DI Small Kick with 14 participants, allowing them the option to compete DI Small or DI Medium Jazz.				
Teams who choose to compete in DI High Kick, one other performance category, and game day will not be able to compete game day with less athletes than the performance category with the highest number of athletes.				
Because DII division sizes are consistent, teams who compete in DII High Kick and one other performance category (Pom, Jazz, or Hip Hop) must stay within their division size.				
Trade out Athletes: - Teams competing in multiple performance categories (Pom, Jazz, and Hip Hop) must stay in the same division size, but can have different number of athletes in each routine. Reminders: Teams are only allowed to compete in two performance categories (Pom, Jazz, Hip Hop, and High Kick) for NDTC. High Kick is only split into Small and Large. See above for High Kick Trade Out rules. - Junior High, Junior Varsity and Varsity Intermediate teams may trade out, remove, or add athletes between their categories, but must follow the Varsity division size rules. - Teams competing in Game Day will not be able to compete with less athletes than the performance category with the highest number of athletes.				

2026 - 2027 SPIRIT PROGRAM GAME DAY DIVISION GUIDELINES

Spirit Program Game Day Divisions will be offered at select regional events and both NSSC weekends.

- Junior High and Varsity divisions will be split.
- Junior Varsity and Varsity teams may combine to compete in one of the SPGD divisions.
- Any team member MUST be registered as the same athlete/performer type throughout the event or event weekend. Example - a dancer can only compete as a dancer at any given regional event or at an NSSC weekend.
- A minimum of 5 athletes must represent each performance group. (cheer, dance, and band)
- A maximum of 75 athletes are allowed in SPGD divisions.
- Up to 2 Mascots are allowed and are not included in the total participant number.

NOTE: UCA and UDA will split divisions in the best interest of providing a competitive environment. When/if a division has 11 or more teams additional splits may be offered. When/if a division has less than 3 teams, they may be combined into the same age/size division.

Please Note: Divisions will be evaluated for changes as needed and updates may be made.
