Spirit Video

The deadline for the Spirit Video component is January 8th. For information regarding spirit video requirements and music guidelines please click <u>here.</u>

Be sure to enter your information first and then upload the video. When the video says "Uploaded" all information has been submitted. There is not an additional submit button. If we did not receive a spirit video, we will notify you by the end of this week.

- Please be sure to include a Title Slide with your School/Team name.
- Photos/Boomerangs will not be counted towards score. Photos used for title slides are acceptable.
- Teams can choose to include their fifth clip with the section it accompanies, or at the end.

Game Day Order

The order for Game Day at NDTC will be:

- 1. Fight Song
- 2. Spirit Raising Performance
- 3. Spirit Video
- 4. Performance Routine

Each component should have a beginning and an end and spiriting is highly encouraged between components. During the Spirit Video portion the video will play on the screens, so spiriting throughout this section is not required. The announcer will call the team onto the floor, but there will not be cues between each component. Music for each component should be on a separate track.

Rules Reminders

- Teams are allowed to use poms for their performance but no other signs/props are allowed.
- Mascots/drumlines are not allowed.
- Time Limits:
 - Fight Song and Spirit Raising Performance 2:00
 - Spirit Video :45
 - ∘ Performance Routine 1:00
 - Overall Time Limit 4:00

Music Guidelines

- The Fight Song component should be performed to band music
- The Spirit Raising Performance component can be to band music or popular music
- The Performance Routine can be to band music or popular music
