
HELP BRAND YOUR SCHOOL


BEYOND THE GAME

Higher School Spirit Equals Higher Involvement

Students with higher levels of school spirit are also more likely to be involved in each of the following than students with low school spirit:



BUILD COMMUNITY

A dance team can be vital in building school spirit beyond just the school. Teams are typically actively engaged in the community by attending parades, events, and participating in community service, spreading spirit beyond the walls of the school!

GRADUATION IMPACT

Students with higher levels of school spirit are **30%** more likely than students with low school spirit to get mostly As or As and Bs in school. High spirited students are 33% more likely to expect to receive a four-year degree or more following high school than students with low school spirit.

Dance team and cheerleading are activities unique to any other. Practices are less about running plays and more about cleaning routines and creating entertaining performances. As an admin, take the time to attend a practice, become involved in a pep rally activity, or ask team members how a competition went.
