

Dear Coaches & Program Directors, Families and Championship Attendees,

We hope you are getting excited for the 2021 Quest Recreational Championship! Below are some important reminders:

- By now you should have received the link to set up a time to check-in at the Varsity Registration Tent in Orlando. You need to make sure you have all forms turned in and your balance is paid in full. Remember, you will receive a Disney confirmation ticket order number once you pay in full (if you have not done so already) for you to go and make a reservation for your group at one of the Theme Parks. No one will be admitted in a Disney park without a park reservation.
- Varsity will not have access to Disney Theme Park passes in Orlando, all reservations must be made by the registration end date. Also, if you have team members that you have rostered and they have not registered, you need to make sure they do ASAP.

On April 6, 2021, the registration system will close in order to plan for your arrival in Orlando. No changes will be accepted on or after this date. If athletes are not registered by this date, they will not be able to compete with the team. Registrations will not be accepted in Orlando.

For parents/fans who are interested in purchasing a ESPN Wide World of Sports Complex only ticket, the online store will be available on April 8th.
