


Hello Coaches,

As we get closer to The Quest Recreational Championship, we have some exciting news to share with you all. Because we want every athlete to experience the championship to the fullest and we know how hard everyone has worked this year, we are excited to announce that for **2021 only** all teams at The Quest will have the opportunity to compete **twice**; once in Semi-Finals and once in Finals. Scoring

Each team will be guaranteed two performances. Twenty five percent of your team's score from Friday's competition and seventy five percent of your

team's score on Saturday will be combined to determine the final overall ranking in each division. Friday's order of competition was randomly drawn in our office. Saturday's performance order will be the reverse order of competition from Friday. We will do our best to accommodate crossovers. For crossover conflicts in times please complete this <u>form.</u>

Awards

The awards shows will air on Varsity TV for free. Teams will be able to pick up their awards at the South side of the Arena between the two sets of stairs, lower level after their awards on Saturday, April 17th until 11 pm and 9:00 am until noon on Sunday, April 18th. Quest Champion coaches will receive an email requesting ring sizes. All banners will be available on-site for pickup and rings will be shipped approximately 8-10 weeks after the event. Only 2 people can come and pick up the awards.
