

# ROUTINE REVIEW PROCESS 1 ROUND EVENT

## RANGE REVIEW PROCESS

Each team will receive a set of score sheets following their performance. If, after reviewing your score sheets, you feel your team was not scored in the appropriate DIFFICULTY range or CAPPED category you may submit a review. Please follow this process:

**DIFFICULTY range** – Stunts, Pyramids, Standing Tumbling\*, or Running Tumbling

**LOW:** 2.5-3.0 **MID:** 3.0-3.5 **HIGH:** 3.5-4.0

*\*L1-5 & Jr 6 teams scoring a 3.5, 3.6 or 3.7, that show a variety and perform passes synchronized or in groups may utilize this process*

**CAPPED category** – Tosses, Stunt/Coed Quantity, Stunt Division Expectations, or Jumps

1. Complete a Routine Review Form. You have **10 MINUTES** following the release of your score sheets to do so.
2. Turn that form into the Scoring Official at AccuSCORE.
3. Your form will be reviewed by the AccuSCORE Scoring Official, who will decide to either honor or deny the request, based on that round's performance.
4. You may pick up your completed Review Form at AccuSCORE prior to awards. If honored, you will receive a new set of score sheets reflecting the change.

**The following ranges are NOT eligible for review:**

**Execution** (Unless the value associated with your drivers do not match the score entered into the system), Stunt Creativity, Pyramid Creativity, Dance, Routine Composition, and Overall Impression.

## DEDUCTION REVIEW PROCESS

This sheet indicates the total number of points that have been deducted due to falls, out of bounds, and legality violations during the routine. Each team will receive a set of score sheets following their performance.

If after reviewing your team's Deduction Sheet you feel that your team was given deductions that were unwarranted, please follow this process:

1. Complete a Routine Review Form (for point deduction) or a USASF Legality Review Form. You have **10 MINUTES** following the release of your score sheets to do so.
2. Turn that form into the Scoring Official at AccuSCORE.
3. Your form will be reviewed by the AccuSCORE Scoring Official, who will decide to either honor or deny the request, based on that round's performance.
4. You may pick up your completed Review Form at AccuSCORE prior to awards. If honored, you will receive a new set of score sheets reflecting the change.

**While reviewing Point Deduction, a Scoring Official will watch the routine in its entirety. Any additional infractions discovered will be assessed to the final score.**

### 2 ROUND EVENT

#### **RANGE REVIEW PROCESS Round 1 & 2**

Each team will receive a set of score sheets following their performance. If, after reviewing your score sheets, you feel your team was not scored in the appropriate DIFFICULTY range or CAPPED category you may submit a review. Please follow this process:

**DIFFICULTY range** – *Stunts, Pyramids, Standing Tumbling\**, or *Running Tumbling*

**LOW:** 2.5-3.0 **MID:** 3.0-3.5 **HIGH:** 3.5-4.0

*\*L1-5 & Jr 6 teams scoring a 3.5, 3.6 or 3.7, that show a variety and perform passes synchronized or in groups may utilize this process*

**CAPPED category** – *Tosses, Stunt/Coed Quantity, Stunt Division Expectations, or Jumps*

**Round 2: If score sheets are handed out prior to awards, you are ONLY allowed to submit a review if your range has changed from Round 1.**

1. Complete a Routine Review Form.  
You have **20 MINUTES (10 MINUTES for a single hall event)** following the release of your score sheets to do so.
2. Turn that form into the Scoring Official at AccuSCORE.
3. Your form will be reviewed by the AccuSCORE Scoring Official, who will decide to either honor or deny the request, based on that round's performance.
4. You may pick up your completed Review Form at AccuSCORE prior to awards. If honored, you will receive a new set of score sheets reflecting the change.

**The following ranges are NOT eligible for review:**

**Execution (Unless the value associated with your drivers do not match the score entered into the system), Stunt Creativity, Pyramid Creativity, Dance, Routine Composition, and Overall Impression.**
