



Hello Coaches and Safety Champions -

Thank you so much for being the Safety Champion for your team for the competition at the Walt Disney World Resort®. We are very excited to welcome you and your team to the event. We have been working very closely with Disney to ensure everyone who comes to the competition, has a fun and safe experience.

For your Safety Champion training, we are going to cover the Role of the Safety Champion in this email. Please read over and familiarize yourself with what is expected.

- There must be one Safety Champion per team that is at least 18 years of age and cannot be an athlete. If you have more than one team, you will need 2, one for each team. For example, if you have a Senior and Junior team, you will need 2.
- If you do need to change your safety champion, please email safetychampion@varsity.com with your team name, new safety champions name and email and we will get that updated.

PRIOR TO ARRIVAL IN ORLANDO:

- Please read the Health and Safety Updates for the Championship that can be found [HERE](#).
- Share all safety information and protocols with everyone from your team as well as all friends and family who will be in Orlando.

ONCE IN ORLANDO:

- The first day you arrive at ESPN Wide World of Sports or at the Coronado Springs Resort, you will need to check in at any Customer Service table. There you will receive your Safety Champion button that you will need to wear during the Championship to identify you.
- Face coverings are required indoors for those not fully vaccinated. Face coverings are required for all guests on Disney and Varsity Buses, regardless of vaccination status. For Disney's Face Mask policy including what is and is not allowed please go [HERE](#).
- Please ensure that your bags and personal items are always attended to. You may have seen in recent news reports that there has been a general rise in

security issues at events across the U.S. related to unattended bags. Unattended bags increase the risk of theft and/or the use of unauthorized technology tracking devices (e.g., AirTags). The best way to protect yourself and your personal belongings is to ensure your bags are always attended to. Please report any unattended items, or suspicious activity related to those items, to a member of our Event Staff. Thank you for your cooperation in keeping your belongings and athletes safe.

- While we would love to have everyone on site all day, we are asking that once your team is done competing for the day that you head back to the resort, or one of the parks, or even Disney Springs.
