

Boosts are cash prizes awarded by the Event Producer to any USASF member program's cheer or dance team that already earned a 2023 Worlds At Large, Partial Paid, or Paid Bid. A maximum of \$100 per athlete/per team may be awarded by an Event Producer during the season (the Bid Boost is only applicable to the number of athletes on the floor at the qualifying event).

Encore - Concord - Showdown	March 4–5 Cabarrus Arena & Events Center, Concord, NC	2 Worlds Bid Boosts (\$100 per athlete/per recipient team)
The American Royale - Sevierville - Nationals	March 11–12 Sevierville Convention Center, Sevierville, TN	3 Worlds Bid Boosts (\$100 per athlete/per recipient team)
Athletic - Atlanta - Nationals	March 18–19 Georgia International Convention Center, Atlanta, GA	3 Worlds Bid Boosts (\$100 per athlete/per recipient team)
Athletic - Orlando - Nationals	March 25–26 Orange County Convention Center, Orlando, FL	1 Worlds Bid Boost (\$100 per athlete/per recipient team)

Note: Eligible programs must have a minimum of 3 teams present at the Bid Boost event to qualify for the cash prize.

Worlds Bid Boost Declaration

- Only teams that already have a bid to the 2023 Cheerleading Worlds are eligible for Bid Boosts
- Bid Boosts will be awarded to the team(s) with the highest Percentage of Perfection score, regardless of division.
- All payments will be made payable to the USASF and mailed to their office (with the exception of teams that already have a PAID Bid). Those payments will be written to the program, and mailed to your gym.
- There is no limit to the number of Bid Boosts a team, or a program, can earn during the season.

Teams who earn a Bid Boost will receive monies directly from Varsity All Star to be applied to their Worlds registration or Worlds-related expenses. If a team either decides not to attend Worlds or Worlds is canceled for any reason, Bid Boost money will need to be returned to Varsity All Star

Tie Breaker Policy

In the event that there is a tie for a Worlds Bid Boost, the following Tie-Breaker policy will apply:

- The bid will be awarded to the team with the least amount of deductions for Performance 2.
- If the deductions for Performance 2 are equal or zero, the team with the least amount of deductions for Performance 1 will be awarded the bid.
- If the deductions for Performance 1 are equal or zero, the bid will be awarded to the team with the highest Performance 2 score in the Overall Impression category.
- If the Performance 2 Overall Impression category scores remain equal, the bid will be awarded to the team with the highest scoring Performance 1 score in the Overall Impression category.
- If the Performance 1 Overall Impression category scores remain equal, the tie will be broken by the Judges' Choice.
