

Varsity Spirit Event Code of Conduct

Varsity Spirit is committed to fostering a safe and welcoming environment at our events. Everyone who attends a Varsity Spirit event (e.g., any activity, camp, special event, or competition), is expected to abide by the following Code of Conduct. This includes but is not limited to the following, irrespective of age: individuals participating in a Varsity Spirit Event and their family members or friends; coaches; gym owners; fans and ticketholders; third party vendors; and event volunteers.

When attending Varsity Spirit Events, you should contribute to a positive environment by behaving in a respectful and appropriate manner. The following conduct is prohibited in all Varsity Spirit Event spaces, and is grounds for removal from a Varsity Spirit Event and/or possible permanent exclusion from any future Varsity Spirit Event:

- Behavior that is unruly, disruptive, aggressive, belligerent, threatening, abusive or violent in nature, including but not limited to bullying, verbal, physical or sexual harassment towards any person of any kind
- Foul, abusive or degrading language
- Obscene gestures or name calling
- Intoxication or other signs of alcohol or substance impairment
- Illicit drug possession or usage
- Vandalism of any Varsity Spirit Event location or its equipment
- Failure to follow the safety or security guidelines or instructions of Varsity Spirit or venue personnel
- Spectator's failure to purchase a ticket for admission to the Varsity Spirit Event through the official
 Varsity Spirit ticket outlet. Tickets are non-transferable and valid only for the Varsity Spirit Event and
 for the days for which the ticket(s) are purchased. Anyone found with counterfeit or altered tickets or
 wristbands will be removed from the Varsity Spirit Event.

Prohibited Items at Varsity Spirit Events. Varsity Spirit may prohibit certain items in accordance with applicable law, which may include weapons, firearms, pepper spray, air horns, and laser pointers. Photography and Media Guidelines

Personal or noncommercial photography and videography must comply with Varsity Spirit's *Photography and Media Guidelines*, which are enforced and available online at https://www.varsity.com/championship-photos/photography/. Unauthorized commercial photography, live streaming, or media capture during performances is prohibited.

Varsity Spirit may prohibit or remove from a Varsity Spirit Event any person for any reason at its discretion. In the event you witness conduct that you reasonably believe to be a violation of this Code of Conduct, please notify Varsity Spirit personnel at the Varsity Spirit Event immediately.
