All Star Sports Pool:

From January 2026 until late April 2026, the Surfboard Bay Pool and the kiddie pool at Disney's All-Star Sports Resort will be closed for maintenance. During this time, the Grand Slam Leisure Pool at Disney's All-Star Sports will continue to be available. Additionally, Guests are welcome to use the other pools throughout Disney's All-Star Resorts, including the Calypso Pool, Piano Pool and kiddie pool at Disney's All-Star Music Resort; and the Fantasia Pool, Duck Pond Pool and kiddie pool at Disney's All-Star Movies Resort.

ESPN Wide World of Sports[®] Food Options

While at the ESPN Wide World of Sports Complex, there are several food options available. Field 20 (between the State Farm Field House and the Athletic Center) will have several food trucks throughout the weekend. Private Buses

Sportsmanship

Varsity Spirit encourages and supports sportsmanship, integrity and fairness among participants, coaches and parents in all facets of the Championship including, but not limited to practice and performance. We strive to uphold the highest standards and promote this to the best of our abilities and believe that coaches/parents are instrumental in promoting and instilling this among their respective performers.

To ensure the most positive experience for all attendees, Varsity asks that the following [Code of Conduct](#) be adhered to at the National Championship:

1. Any questions or concerns that affect a team's performance or experience must be communicated by the coach to the Event Director. The appropriate Official will then be called to discuss the situation with the coach.

2. Participants, coaches, gym/studio owners or spectators are prohibited from contacting the Judges during the competition.
3. Judges' rulings are final related to deductions, final team placements and legalities.
4. Any unruly, aggressive, or belligerent behavior by participants, coaches or spectators toward any other attendee or Event Staff will result in a deduction, potential team disqualification, removal from the event and/or barred participation from future Varsity Regionals and Championships.
5. Varsity Spirit reserves the right to remove any person from a competition for unsafe or unsportsmanlike conduct.

Photography and Video Policy

All official team photographers or videographers must be listed on a team roster as personnel for the 2025-26 season. Proof of membership with USASF is required and will be verified on site before the pass is distributed. All Team Photographers/Videographers must request their Team Photography credentials on-site at each event at Registration Check-In to complete the request process and receive credentials. **Approved team photographers will be issued an arm band credential at registration, which must be visible and worn at all times throughout the event. This is how you will be identified as an approved team photographer.**

If you wish to photograph multiple programs at an event or are not listed on the team roster, you must complete the [Media Credential Request Form](#). For additional information about the Team Photography and Videography Policy and Varsity Spirit Event Media Policy, [click here](#).

If these rules are not followed, you will receive a verbal warning and will have to delete the content. If you do not follow this policy for a second time, you will be removed from the warm up area.

Here are the Rules & Guidelines for Photography and video for the 2025-2026 event season:

It is crucial that we all play our part in ensuring privacy, safety, and respect for all teams. As a team photographer, your support and commitment to following the rules and guidelines below are vital to maintaining a positive event environment.

1. **Backstage/warm-up room photography or videography of any kind is strictly prohibited.** Photography or videography, including professional and personal cameras or video devices, is prohibited in the warmup area or any backstage area.
2. No photography or videography from this event can be offered for purchase or resold for any purpose.
3. Lighting equipment, flash photography, monopods/ bipods/ tripods or drone equipment are not permitted.
4. Footage of full performances may not be published on the Internet or any other media, including, but not limited to, YouTube, Facebook, X (Twitter), TikTok, Instagram, and other streaming and/or social media platforms.
5. Single clips of footage used for publication from any single performance on the Internet or any other media may not exceed thirty (30) seconds in length per clip and may not include a full performance.
6. Team Photographers are not permitted to display any live video portions of any performance on the Internet or any other media, including, without limitation, via technologies such as YouTube, Facebook, X (Twitter), TikTok, Instagram, and other streaming and/or social media platforms.
7. Content captured by a designated team photographer cannot be distributed outside of the Program for commercial use.
8. Only one (1) team photographer is allowed for each performance.
9. For events held at the Walt Disney World Resort, photography and videography is not allowed in hotel rooms or public areas such as pools, restaurants, and hotel grounds.
10. Team Photographers will be required to follow the spectator group in and out of the venue and remain in the designated viewing area for spectators unless the event has a specified area for team photographers. Photography and videography will be permissible only in the designated areas, provided that it does not interfere with Varsity Spirit photographers, Varsity TV, personnel, or the conduct of the event.

11. For the privacy and safety of the athletes, photos or videos of any athlete injury should not be shared, distributed or published.
12. Team Photographers must abide by the Event Staff's requests. Please be courteous and respectful to our staff and other media.

- USASF Check-in Please have all coaches/personnel who need to show their USASF Coaches ID to get their wristband come to the registration area with you. This is just a reminder that any coach, choreographer, owner or personnel wishing to access the warmup area, backstage or coaches' box must have a wristband.
- Must have a printed copy of your Compliance Cover Sheet and Program Summary Sheet to turn in at registration. USASF Rosters will lock on Tuesday 4/28/2026 at 5:00pm EST.

 - Must be an eligible coach listed on the USASF event roster.

Please be sure to check the local Orlando TV stations for weather the week leading up to the Championship. We suggest being prepared for rain including umbrellas and ponchos as well as for cooler weather. Competition will continue to happen and any changes in that will be communicated through the BAND groups and in the Complex.

Optional Open Practice

We will be offering CHEER open practice for teams on the commuter package at ESPN Wide World of Sports in the Arena warm up rooms. Practice is first come, first served and availability is limited. Teams will have **15 minutes** on a warmup floor for each team performance. Transportation will not be provided for the commuter team Open Practice.

Cheer teams on the hotel travel package will have practice at Coronado Springs Resort Veracruz Ballroom. Commuter teams will have open practice at the complex.

You must complete your registration with The D2 Summit prior to coming to Open Practice and must scan your athlete or coach credential card to get into ESPN Wide World of Sports or the Coronado Springs Convention Center Ballrooms.

ESPN Wide World of Sports Complex – Cheer Team Optional Open Practice

The Complex will be closed on Wednesday so you cannot stay to practice outside.

Wednesday, May 6, 2026 9:00am - 9:00pm

Thursday, May 7, 2026 9:00am - 9:00pm

- Do not arrive at the Complex more than 20 minutes before your scheduled open practice time. When you arrive, please go to the Arena and enter through the doors between the two staircases.
- Disney will be scanning tickets to get into Open Practice so please bring that with you.
- Once your rehearsal is done, please leave the complex within 30 minutes. The Complex will be closed so you cannot stay to practice outside.
- A head coach must be present with each team. All coaches must have their USASF/USA Cheer membership wristband to gain access to the practice facility. Only the rostered team and coaches are allowed - Spectators will not be allowed.
- Water bubblers will be provided for teams but please plan to bring a water bottle for each athlete.
- Sound systems will be provided for music, but coaches will be responsible for having any adapters/dongles.

Arrival and Competition Flow

We suggest you arrive no more than 45 minutes prior to your warm up time. When you arrive at ESPN Wide World of Sports Complex, you will need to enter the gates using your athlete or coach credential card that you will get at registration. Just a reminder that children under the age of 10 that are not athletes cannot go into warm up or backstage.

- If you would like to do any pre-warm up time, you can do that on Field 18 which is near Field 20 where the food trucks are.
- You will need to report to your warm up venue at the scheduled check in time.
- When entering the venues, please do not play any team sounds systems and music while making your way to the warm up area. Competition is going on and this is distracting to other teams and the competition floor. Once you check in, you will have your team picture taken.
- You will then have your warm up time on a marley floor.
- Once your warm up is complete, you will report backstage (see maps in earlier section for flow) for competition.
- The coach will then be directed to the music table where they will play the music.
- After your performance, the team and coach will meet backstage and watch a replay together of your teams performance.
- You will then gather your bags and exit the venue.
- Please see the event schedule for times and locations of advancement announcements.
- Please do not play any music inside the venues except in warm up and on the main stage. This includes all hallways to/around warm up.

Warm up and Stretching

Field 18 is the designated stretching and warm up areas for the Championship. Please do not use any other area, including the inside of the Baseball Stadium. You will have a designated warm up in the Competition Venue warm up room prior to your performance as well. That time is listed on the Event Order of Competition.

Warm up Guidelines

- Teams will have 12 minutes on a full floor (9-strip mat/10-strip marley).
- Music is allowed during this time.

General reminder for all warm up areas:

- Team music/sound systems cannot be played inside the venues at any time. You may only play music while on the warm up floor. We suggest athletes use personal devices with headphones if they want to hear music prior to warm up inside the venues.
- If your team is using powder on their hands or feet, please do not wipe your hands on any other surfaces including walls, drape, etc.

Dressing Rooms and Personal Belongings

There are limited changing areas at ESPN Wide World of Sports.

- **State Farm Field House:** Restrooms for changing are located on the lower level in the hall behind the judges platform.
- **Athletic Center:** There are a few small locker rooms for quick changes behind the Judges Platform.
- **AdventHealth Arena:** There are limited restrooms on the lower level as well as restrooms on the main concourse.

When changing in these areas, please utilize them as quick changing areas and please do not stay in the area for an extended time. Varsity accepts no responsibility for lost or stolen items. We recommend that each team designate someone to keep an eye on its possessions. **Please do not leave any of your bags unattended as they could be seen as unattended bags and security could be called.**

Team/Personal Sounds Systems at ESPN Wide World of Sports

Team/Personal Sounds Systems must be kept at a reasonable level. Music and songs with explicit lyrics cannot be played. Teams playing explicit music will be asked to turn off their sound system. This includes inside and outside the venues. Any team sound systems must be turned off when you enter the competition venues. Sound systems used in warm up must be the official event sound system and not be played when walking to and from warm up to competition.

Awards

- All participants will receive 1 commemorative medallion per athlete.
- Teams who qualify for Finals in each division will be awarded a team finalist banner.
- Teams that place 1st, 2nd, or 3rd in their respective division will receive a team banner and each participant will receive individual mini banners recognizing their accomplishment.
- All divisional champions will receive exclusive D2 Summit Championship Rings! Each rostered athlete will receive a ring. Each team will also receive 6 additional rings to distribute how they choose (Coaches, Choreographers, etc)
- Awards times and location can be found on the Block Schedule.
- Teams will report approximately 15 minutes prior to their scheduled awards.
 - Teams should leave all bags (if possible) with family prior to reporting to awards.
 - International division Cheer Teams on Friday for International awards, will report to the Athletic Center warmup entrance to line up for awards.
 - Cheer teams on Sunday will report to the athlete entrance in the Awards venue they are listed and will line up for awards.

Practice at Disney Resorts for Hotel Travel Package Guest only

We know that many teams like to do quick run throughs and marking of their routines. For your safety, please follow the guidelines below. Only hotel resort guests are allowed on property to practice.

Disney's All-Star Resort

- Recommended Practice Locations:
 - Inside the designated practice space enclosure located in the parking lot between Disney's All-Star Music and Disney's All-Star Movies
 - Football Field at Disney's All-Star Sports Resort
 - Center Court at Disney's All-Star Sports Resort
- Practice can take several forms such as blocking or full routine which may or may not incorporate stunts.
- Stunting is restricted to be performed only on grass (real or artificial) or rubberized track surface.
- Practice should not impact quiet hours (11 pm until 7 am) or other Guests including Championship Guests and non-Championship Guests.
- Practice should not occur in parking lots outside of the designated practice space.

If teams are practicing in areas not indicated above, they will be asked to move to one of the areas above. Thank you for assistance in this for your safety.

Disney's Coronado Springs Resort

Designated practice locations at Disney's Coronado Springs Resort would be in the coned off area in the Rancho's Parking lot and the grassy area at Casitas 4.

- Practice should not impact quiet hours or other Guests including Championship Guests and non-Championship Guests.
- Practice should not occur in parking lots outside of the designated practice space.
- Practice should not occur on Artificial Grass Area outside of the El Destino Tower
- Practice should not occur in any of the Convention Center Hallways

Score Sheets, Deductions and Legality sheets will be emailed out about 15-20 minutes after the team's performance. If you have not received your score sheets 30 minutes after performance, please go to the score sheet table located in the venue that you performed.

- State Farm Field House – located on the exit side of the judges platform.
- Athletic Center – located directly behind the judges platform.
- Arena East & Arena West – located on the lower level athlete entrance.

Cheer - If coaches have any scoring questions, an official may assist you throughout the weekend at the AccuScore area located in The State Farm Field House on the lower level next to the judge's platform exit side of the venue.

As always, our Event Staff is here to assist you, so if you need something, ask someone in a blue Event Staff t-shirt. If they cannot assist, they will find someone who can.

Hit Zero Buttons

Teams can receive Hit Zero Buttons at any of the score sheet table locations in the venue by showing your zero-deduction sheet on a mobile device.
