- Each team will receive the following warm-up:
 - o 8 mins 18' x 42 Foam Floor
 - o 8 mins 12' x 69' Spring Tumble Strip
 - o 4 mins 42' x 54' Foam Floor (with audio)
- * More information on the amount of time per station will be provided closer to the event.

Scoring:

- Scoresheets will be sent to the email attached to the team, or registration contact, approximately 15-20 minutes after each performance. Paper copies will be available upon request at the scoresheet table.
- ACCUscore will be located directly behind the Judging Platform. Any requests for review must be submitted within 10 minutes after the scoresheets have been emailed. *The coaches attached to your teams will receive their team's scoresheets at the event ONLY if their email AND mobile phone number is added and correct on the portal account.
- Final results will be provided to all coaches, following awards.
